CORE LEANING TASK FOR ENGLISH SPELLING FOCUS

SpaG

Today, we are going to focus on the conjunction 'when'. Please write 2/3 sentences which have the conjunction 'when' in them. Please see Miss Hough's video online to show you how to set out your work.

MAIN

We have now come to the end of reading Wind in the Willows. Today, we would like you to:

- 1. Recap with yourself/ an adult what has happened in this story.
- 2. Answer the following questions:
 - Who are the main characters?
 - Where do they live?
 - Is Toad a good or bad character? How do you know?
- 3. Answer the questions about the Wind in the Willows which have been assigned to you on SeeSaw. Watch Miss Hough's video which shows how to answer these questions.

GUIDED READING

Individual reading tasks have been assigned on SeeSaw. Please record yourself reading and answering questions.

CORE LEARNING TASK FOR MATHEMATICS

<u>STARTER</u>

Let's remind ourselves about place value. Please watch the short starter and use the more than, less than and equal to symbols to make the statements correct.

MAIN TASKS

Today we are exploring additiona and subtraction as opposites.

- 1. Look at the words for addition and subtraction. What do you notice?
- 2. If we know addition and subtraction are the inverse of each, other we can use this to solve missing number problems. Especially when we see it on a part whole.
- 3. Please watch Miss Rimmer solve missing number problems and then have a go yourself. Together you will go through some examples.
- 4. Please watch how Miss Rimmer displays her work using the squares. Please copy this into your books when you answer the questions.
- 5. Please answer the questions on the powerpoint. **A** is slightly easier than **B**. Make sure you are comfortable before challenging yourself!

<u>CHALLENGE</u>

True or false, explain why. **If 15 + 18 = 33, then 18 - 15 = 33.** Use the part whole method to help you.
