### CORE LEARNING TASK FOR ENGLISH

Today in English we are continuing to hear about that trickster Brer Rabbit! Watch the video with Miss Barrett and listen to the story.



You have then been assigned a task on Seesaw, playing a game to explore some of the unusual vocabulary. You will need to find a dice, or be creative making numbers to pick at random.

### CORE LEARNING TASK FOR MATHEMATICS

Today in math's we are looking at written method for division. In particular we will be 'chunking'.

Here we use our knowledge of key times tables to solve a division question.

$$73 \div 5$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 5 \overline{) 73} \\ - 50 \\ \hline 23 \\ - 20 \\ \hline 3 \end{array}$$

(10 x 5)      (4 x 5)

10 + 4 = 14

How many 5s have been subtracted?  
14 sets of 5, with 3 left over.

$$\text{Answer: } 73 \div 5 = 14 \text{ r}3$$
