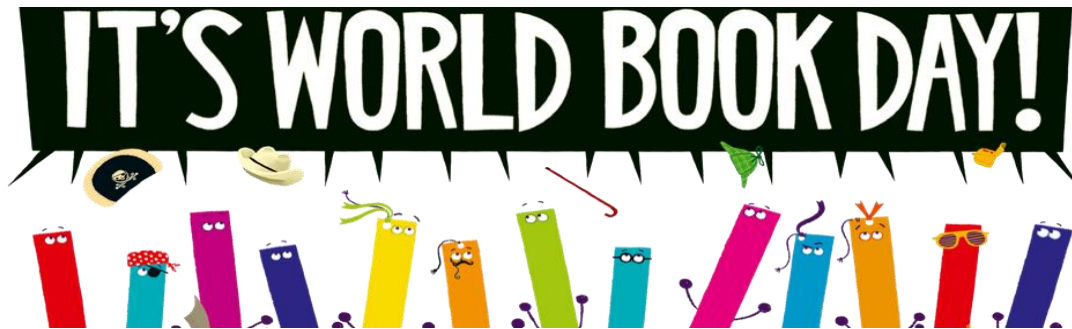

You might want to write about a heroic hero who saves the day from broccoli by eating it as part of their five a day! Or even, a new story from the Brilliant Book Award 'The One Stop Story Shop' with Ferret and the Knight! You might want to share everything you know about sharks or cars or chocolate! You are free to choose whatever you like and be as imaginative as possible.

2. On the remote learning page you will also find a template to write on for both the creative writing and non chronological report. Or you can simply write straight into your remote learning book. Don't forget to add or draw pictures to make your text interesting!
