

#### MOTOR SKILLS TASK

**Curly Caterpillar Letters -** Today we are going to continue to use our writing paper from Tuesday to practise our caterpillar letters. Watch the video of Mrs Hanson modelling our letters for today.

One Arm Robot Letters - Today we are going to continue to practise all of our letter sets by writing words that contain all of our letter groups. Use the lined paper in your remote learning book to copy out these words: First start with your name, practice this three times using your rainbow name card that you made during Elmer week.

After that have a go at these tricky words:


Monster Zig Zag Letters and Long Ladder Letters - today we are going to practise writing our names. You will need your rainbow name card that you made during Elmer week. Ask a parent to draw a straight line on a piece of paper. Try to copy your name with each letter sitting on the line. Remember to start each letter (except the capital) with your lead in stroke from the line. Try to write your name three times.

### MATHEMATICS TASK

Today we are going to carry on doubling a number. Watch the video of Miss Brown where she will explain today's activity.

You will need: a dice, small objects such as cubes, bricks or cars and a pencil and paper.

You are going to complete the same activity as yesterday but today we are going to be writing down number sentences to go with each number we double.



### PHONICS TASK

BLUES – On espresso, search for 'Scrap's Phonics' and select /h/. Play 'match the word to the picture.'

YELLOWS – ask a grown-up to draw 6 simple worms (big enough to write a word inside) and write the following words in the middle of a worm: tick/tock/pens/rock/mill/puff. Now ask them to hide the worms in your garden. How many words can you find and read? Practise reading and writing the caption: run up the hill

REDS – on Phonics Play, play 'Tricky Word Trucks'. Select 'phase 2 tricky words'

Now play 'Buried Treasure.' Select phase 3 and either j/v/w or x. Practise reading and writing the caption: fox in a box

**PURPLES** – Can you remember the sound you learnt yesterday? /igh/

Today's new sound: **/oo/.** It makes two sounds: **a short sound and a long sound**. Join in with Miss Brown on seesaw and then on espresso, watch both videos on **'Polly's Phonics'** for **/oo/** and practise saying the sounds.

On espresso now play 'sorting oo short/oo long'

GREENS – Quickwrite: ask a grown-up to say the following sounds: or/ar/oi/ow/er/ur Practise writing them down. You could do this outside on the floor using chalk.

On **Phonics Play**, play **Buried Treasure**. Select **phase 3** and then select any of the following digraphs: **or/ar/oi/ow/er/ur**.

Practise reading and writing the sentence: The owl will hoot at night.
