
Then follow Mrs Sheppard's video as she guides you through the story mountain, and offers you options to choose from, so that your story is personalised!

### CORE LEARNING TASK FOR MATHEMATICS



To complete our full week on the mathematical number operation of division we are going to look at word problems in more detail.

To begin with though we would like you to continue your work on multiplication and division facts using the Daily 10 challenge (levels found on the video). You may even want to continue working towards your Badge 12 in this time.

Once you have completed this task watch the daily video by Mr. Stanton which looks at the chunking method again. Then work on the questions set choosing an appropriate place to start. The questions for the Squares, Pentagons and Hexagons have a hidden sting in the tail. Some of the questions are multi step and might not just involve division so be careful. ### KEY VOCABULARY

This week, you have focused on understanding how to spell words ending in suffixes that begin with a vowel (-ed, -ing, en, -er). Today we will be solidifying our knowledge by answering a few quiz questions and writing down sentences that Mrs Sheppard will dictate.
