There is no need for a date or L.O as we will copy these for an in-class display. Be creative!

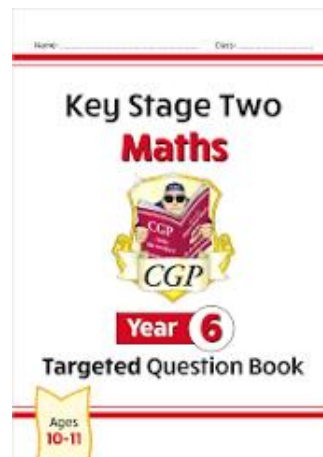
