CORE LEARNING TASK

MATHEMATICS TASK

Today, we are going to get musical with our maths activity. First you need to make a set of number cards 1-10. Next, you need to collect your instrument – a pot or pan and a wooden spoon, (or something similar).

Shuffle the number cards and place them face down. Take turns with an adult to turn over a number and tap for pot or pan 'that many times' with your spoon. Therefore, if you turn over number 7, you tap your pan 7 times. Repeat for all of the numbers. If your counting is accurate, you could increase the numbers to 15 and then 20.

GROUP 1

Today we would like you to re-cap the sound /c/. Follow this link to BBC Bitesize: <https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/zf2yf4j>

Watch the video for the /c/ sound and also the one for the tricky words – **I the to no go.**

Next using the sounds you have learnt so far – s a t p l n m d g o c, have a go at making some of your own words. You could write the sounds on cards and use them to create your words, or write the words yourself. See if you can make 10 words using all of the sounds at least once.



GROUP 2

Today we would like you to re-cap the sound /m/. On Espresso, search 'Phonics' and click on 'Scrap's Phonics'. Click on the sound /m/ and watch the short video. Next, follow this link to PhonicsPlay:
