CORE LEARNING TASK FOR ENGLISH

The Day the Crayons Quit

Following on from Tuesday's work based on the story of 'The Day the Crayons Quit', can the children make their own crayon and describe how that crayon is feeling? Encourage the children to explain why the crayon is feeling like this based on their reading:

*I am Red crayon. I am feeling _____ because _____.
I also feel _____ because _____.*

This is showing that the children understand what they have read. Their crayon can be completed in any form: 3D, painted, sketched etc. Please send us pictures to show which crayon you have made!



If the children finish this, please could they write an apology letter from Duncan to one of the crayons explaining why he was using this particular crayon the way he did and explaining what he can do to make it better. Children can complete this in their Remote Learning Book, use the template which is on the Year 2 Remote Learning page or type the letter on a device. Any pictures or emails of the letters would be great!

CORE LEARNING TASK FOR MATHEMATICS

Today, we would like the children to go on a shape hunt and find all of the 2D and 3D shapes. We would like the children to draw the object they find, write the name of the shape and name their edges, faces and vertices. This can be completed in their work book.

INFORMATION

2D Shapes

Are flat. You cannot hold them. You cannot pick them up.

3D shapes

Are not flat. You can hold them. You can pick them up.
