


CORE LEARNING TASK FOR ENGLISH

Good morning everyone! Hope you are well. This work can be spread out over two days. Don't rush it.

Here is a piece of text. Can you do three things? Read it and...

1. Identify any vocabulary you would love to use. Write some new sentences with your favourite vocabulary in.
2. Find any subordinate clauses. Remember – they don't have to be at the start of a sentence.
3. Play 'Brilliant to Boring' - find a brilliant sentence. What makes it brilliant? Think about its structure. Re-write it in a boring way. It sounds daft but it really helps you to see how amazing the brilliant sentence is! For example – 'The delicious apple, glowing on the table like a globe in the sunlight, was so tempting to eat' could be 'The nice apple was on the table and I wanted to eat it'



CORE LEARNING TASK FOR MATHEMATICS

We need to learn more about the passing of time.

During the day, calculate how long it takes to do tasks. Write it down. For example:

Went for a walk – 35 minutes
Ate tea – 25 minutes
Art – 55 minutes



Add two or three of your total times together. Try different combinations. Don't forget to convert to hours and minutes too.

Tea + walk = 60 mins = 1 hour
Art + tea = 80 mins = 1 hour 20 mins
