KEY VOCABULARY

Lava	Semi-fluid rock erupted from a volcano
Mantle	The layer of earth between the Earth's crust and core
Magma	Semi-fluid rock beneath the Earth's surface.
Tectonic plates	Part of the Earth's surface that move in relation to one another
Algorithm	A list of steps to solve a problem

During the last half term we have focused on understanding and using the above vocabulary.

In Geography, use the correct vocabulary to write about what causes an earthquake. You can model it perhaps with two pieces of bread at breakfast or with a Lego board. Take a photo or draw - add labels.
