CORE LEANING TASK FOR ENGLISH

CORE LEARNING TASK FOR MATHEMATICS

Please complete the assigned tasks on Mathletics. Your username and passcode are in the Remote Learning book.

Explore Espresso on Discovery Education. Your login and password are in the Remote Learning book. Hover over the Foundation area and select Maths then Writing number 0-20.

Begin by watching the 4 videos. All the videos focus on number formation. Once you have finished watching the videos, click on 'activities' down the left hand side and fill in the missing numbers on the number line. You can use your number line in your Remote Learning Pack to help you. Next practise writing down some different numbers. Ask someone at home to give you some numbers between 0-20 and write them down in your Remote Learning Book. To extend your learning, you could write down the numbers that are one more and/or one less than the number given to you. Finally ask someone to write down a selection of numbers from 0-20 on separate pieces of paper, for example 9, 10, 11 and 12. Mix the numbers up, see if you can place them in the correct order and stick them in your Remote Learning Book.
