CORE LEANING TASK FOR ENGLISH

Choose one of the pictures in your learning pack from a part of the story. There are lines underneath to write on. Write two (or three sentences) about the picture.

Model to your child about punctuation - they will sing "Capital let-ter..." with a 'C' hand shape for the start of the sentence. They will do a "full-stop dooosh" action for the full stop at the end!

Check that it makes sense (no missing words) and that there are finger spaces.

The Sentence Check Song

'You do the sentence check, you do the sentence check, You do the three tick sentence check!'

Write a tick after you read back to check your written sentence. Tick in the bottom corner for:

Tick - a capital letter

Tick - a full stop

Tick - finger spaces.

Does your sentence make sense? Well done!



CORE LEARNING TASK FOR MATHEMATICS

Please complete the assigned tasks on Mathletics. Your username and passcode are in the Remote Learning book.

Today we are going to focus on subtraction.

Collect your worms from Tuesday, but today you will only need 10. Begin by placing the 10 worms in a line. Roll your dice and take away this number of worms (or choose a number from your cup) Pretend a bird has flown past and eaten them!

How many worms do you have left? Count the worms that are left. To extend your learning, write the number sentence in your Remote Learning.

Book for example; 10 - 6 = 4

To extend further, try counting back from ten to complete a subtraction. Begin with ten worms/ objects. Roll your dice and count back the number that the dice lands on, for example, number 4. Hold up 4 fingers. Count back 4 like this: Say, "10 in my head ... count back 4 ... 9, 8, 7, 6." The answer is 6.

In school, the children have been practising making the - and = sign using their arms. Encourage them to do this and to talk about what they are doing, for example; I have 10 worms. A bird comes along and takes away 6. I have 4 left altogether.
