### **EASTER ACTIVITY 1- HISTORY**

### SEASIDE PROJECT

We would like the children to create a project based on the Seaside: Then and Now. This would be our topic in the Summer Term and it is a good way to compare how the seaside has changed over the years. The children need to research what the Seaside was like in the past (Victorian era) and what the Seaside is like today. We would like you to give your project the following title:

### **SEASIDE: THEN and NOW**

This project can be completed in any way you would like. This project can be completed in the form of a poster, an information booklet, a travel brochure, a presentation (the children have been taught how to use PowerPoint at school which is a great way to display information) and/ or a 3D scene of the Seaside both past and present i.e half and half. There is a wealth of information online and maybe even ask grandparents what the seaside was like!

### <u>IDEAS</u>

- Look in travel brochures for pictures of where to go on holiday to the seaside. Cut and stick to create a collage a page of seaside destinations now and seaside destinations in the past.
- Past and present seaside holiday comparisons- comparing transport, clothes, where to stay, where to buy ice cream on the beach, activities.
- Create postcards for both Seaside: Then and Seaside: Now.
