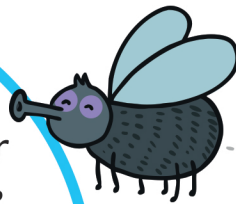


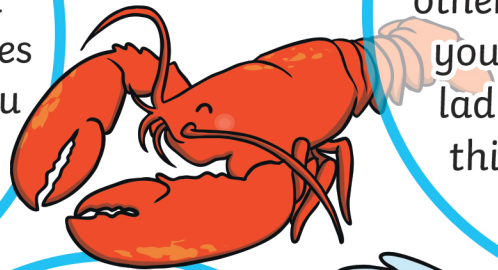
The Bad Tempered Ladybird

Home Learning Challenge

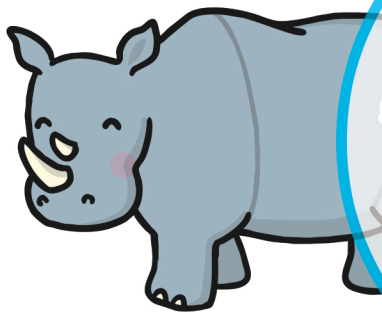
Go on a minibeast hunt in your garden or around your local park. What minibeasts can you find? You could take pictures or draw the minibeasts you find. Why not take these into school to show your class?



The Bad Tempered Ladybird is grumpy and not very kind to the other animals. Why don't you try to be a friendly ladybird and do 3 kind things for someone in your house?



The Bad Tempered Ladybird meets lots of different animals in the story. Can you think of an animal with 4 legs? Can you think of an animal with 6 legs? Can you think of an animal with 8 legs?



Which is your favourite animal in the story? Can you make your own? Try using lots of different materials.



Talk to a grown-up about all the different places the animals in the story might live. How many live in your country? How many live in a different country? Do you see some of them in your local area? Do you see some in a zoo? Write down a list of all the places the animals might live.

Make your own timeline for the different things you do each day at home. Start with what time you wake up and finish with when you go to bed. Think about what time you have breakfast, go to the park, have lunch, and watch TV. See how many activities you can fit into your day.
