## KEY VOCABULARY

<b>Queen</b>	a female ruler of a country who is not elected but whose mother, father, or relative was the ruler before her.
<b>coronation</b>	the ceremony at which a king or queen is crowned
<b>crown</b>	a covering for the head often made of gold or silver and decorated with jewels
<b>ceremony</b>	a formal act or series of acts done in a particular way to honor a special occasion.
<b>Archbishop</b>	a bishop of the highest rank.
<b>Princess</b>	a daughter or granddaughter of a king or queen.
<b>heir</b>	the next in line to the throne leaves that form part

## SCIENCE

It is our last week learning all about plants and trees. We would like you to make your own tree out of different materials you have at home. Make sure you label the different parts of your tree, e.g. leaves, roots, branches and trunk.

## SPELLING/PHONICS FOCUS

It is important for Year One children to apply their phonics knowledge in reading and spelling at all times. Use the Phonic Guidance and activity booklets provided (booklets also available on the Year 1 class webpage) to support teaching phonic sounds.

This week's focus will be on the Newsletter.

We are focusing on teaching children to: Sound out a word before they write it. Say it clearly. Write all the letters and sounds they hear.

Ongoing task-

Practise reading and spelling the 100 high frequency words for Year 1 (see below Year 1 Newsletter).

## KEY MENTAL MATHS SKILLS TO REHEARSE ORALLY

It is important in Year 1 to rehearse counting in 2, 5 and 10. Try counting on from different starting point too. Confidence in number bonds to ten and twenty is also important.
