### CORE LEARNING TASK FOR ENGLISH

Watch the video **Insects** on espresso. To locate this video please type '**insects**' in the search box at the top. Then click on '**insects**' F. Insects are minibeasts. They have six legs and three parts to their body: **a head, a thorax and an abdomen**. They do not have a backbone.

Listen carefully to the video and see if you can answer any of the questions below.

- Where do you find many insects?
- How many body parts do insects have?
- How many legs do insects have?
- Can you name any of the insects mentioned in this video?
- Can you think of any other insects that live in the garden or wood?

Now research your own insect using books and/or the internet and see what interesting facts you can find.

Draw your insect and underneath write some sentences/phrases about your insect.

Don't forget a super sentence needs **a capital letter, finger spaces** and **a full stop**!



### CORE LEARNING TASK FOR MATHEMATICS

Please complete the assigned tasks on Mathletics. In our core learning, we are going to continue to learn about **time**.

On espresso click on **key stage 1 > maths > time > videos > day on the farm part 1 & 2**

Please watch both videos. Each one talks through a day on the farm and shows the different times things happen. Ask a grown up to read the different times to you and see if you can say what is happening at each time on the farm. *Please read the analogue time to your child NOT the digital time as this may confuse them.*

Have a go at making your own clock. You could get creative and cut out your own circle, add your numbers and cut out a short and long hand and attach them using a split pin. You could even use pipe cleaners for the hands, sticking them on with a blob of blutack! Be as creative as you'd like!
