CORE LEARNING TASK FOR ENGLISH

This week, we will be looking at different inventions. Today we will be discovering some inventions that were created by accident!

CORE LEARNING TASK FOR MATHEMATICS

This week, we will be revisiting Perimeter and Area of regular and compound shapes.

Remember that Perimeter is the distance around the edge of a shape and Area is the amount of space that the shape takes up.

Perimeter

The perimeter is the distance around the outside or edge of a shape or area.

It can be measured in mm, cm, m or km
