CORE LEARNING TASK FOR MATHEMATICS

This week, we will be revisiting Perimeter and Area of regular and compound shapes.

Remember that Perimeter is the distance around the edge of a shape and Area is the amount of space that the shape takes up.

<u>Task</u>

Complete the two worksheets (found on the Remote Learning page)
Start with Area of Rectangles and then move onto Area of Compound
Shapes. (Remember to split the compound shape up into rectangles and work
out the length of the sides to help.)

Perimeter

The perimeter is the distance around the outside or edge of a shape or area.

It can be measured in mm, cm, m or km

Area

The <u>area</u> is the total surface of a shape or space.

It can be measured in mm², cm², m² or
