### CORE LEARNING TASK FOR ENGLISH

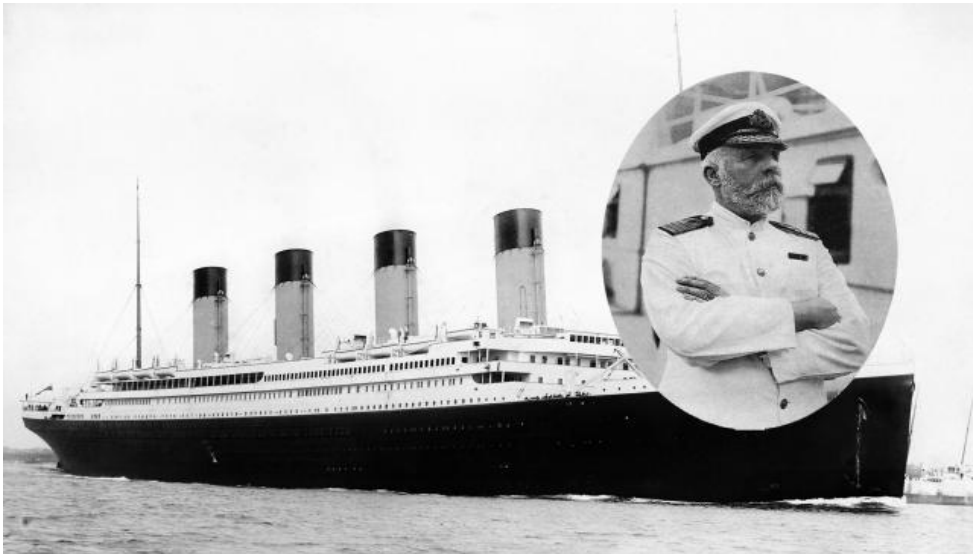
This week we will be looking at the Titanic – before it sank!

### CORE LEARNING TASK FOR MATHEMATICS

This week we will be focusing on using mental methods to solve calculations. Today, we will focus on addition and subtraction. In class, we have looked at various ways to do this, such as partitioning, rounding and adjusting, using a number line to count on, and using known facts. We know that using mental methods **does not mean** that you have to do the whole calculation in your head. We use jottings to help. It means that you do not do the written column method.

Once you have refreshed your knowledge, complete the assigned Mathematics tasks:

- Split addition and subtraction
- Jump to addition and subtraction
- Pyramid Patterns.

Remember that you can always use the information tool on Mathematics to help you as well.
