CORE LEANING TASK FOR ENGLISH

Read Chapter 1 together of The Abominables by Eva Ibbotson. Available on the Year 4 remote learning page as a PDF.

Plan out and write a newspaper report from the day that Agatha disappeared.

Think about the following:

Who is your report about?

Who was there at the time of the disappearance?

What has happened?

Where did it happen?

When did it happen?

Set your newspaper out properly.

Include the following:

- a headline (Is it catchy? You could use alliteration)
- a picture
- an introductory paragraph that briefly includes the 5 Ws (who, what, why, where, when) $\,$
- Use the past tense and third person (he, she, it or they)
- Put the information in chronological (time) order A quote from an eyewitness (maybe Agatha's father)
- write in columns

Try to include some of the Year 4 grammar/ sentence types that you have looked at with your teacher. Read your work through and check for spelling and punctuation.


CORE LEARNING TASK FOR MATHEMATICS
