CORE TASK 1

ENGLISH

Last week, we completed reading our class text 'Mossop's Last Chance'. The children have really enjoyed the story all about a tired old cat's last chance on the Mudpuddle Farm.

Today, we would like your child to change the main character of the story from a cat to another farm animal and think of a new problem that animal would have on the farm. Can they then have a go at writing the opening to the story? Today we only ask the children to write the 'opening' and the 'build up'.


In Year 2, the children are expected to write successful sentences using their phonic knowledge, capital letters, full stops and simple conjunctions like 'because, so, and'.
