Task Two


This week, you are going to look at other ways to separate mixtures. Follow the **Science Resource two** slides, completing the work neatly in your remote learning book.

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MATHS CORE LEARNING TASKS MENTAL METHODS FOR ADDITION.

MONDAY – Developing strategies to add numbers mentally.

Watch the video that I have made for you which will introduce to two methods that can help you add numbers mentally. Then follow the Maths Monday slides and answer the questions provided, in your Remote Learning book.

<u>TUESDAY</u> - **Developing further strategies to add numbers mentally.**

Watch the video that I have made for you which will introduce to another two methods that can help you add numbers mentally. Then follow the Maths Tuesday slides and answer the questions provided, in your Remote Learning book.

<u>WEDNESDAY</u> – **Adding large numbers mentally.**

Watch the video that I have made for you which will show you how to use the methods that you have been practising, and apply them to larger numbers. Follow the Maths Wednesday slides and answer the questions provided, in your Remote Learning book.

THURSDAY – Adding large numbers using the formal written method.

Watch the video that I have made for you which will remind you of the formal written method that you have used in Year 4. Follow the Maths Thursday slides which give you a chance to practise this method with increasingly large numbers.

FRIDAY – Adding large numbers using the formal written method.

Today we will continue to practise this method but move onto setting the columns out yourself. We will also try some missing number problems. Watch the video before completing Maths Friday slides.
