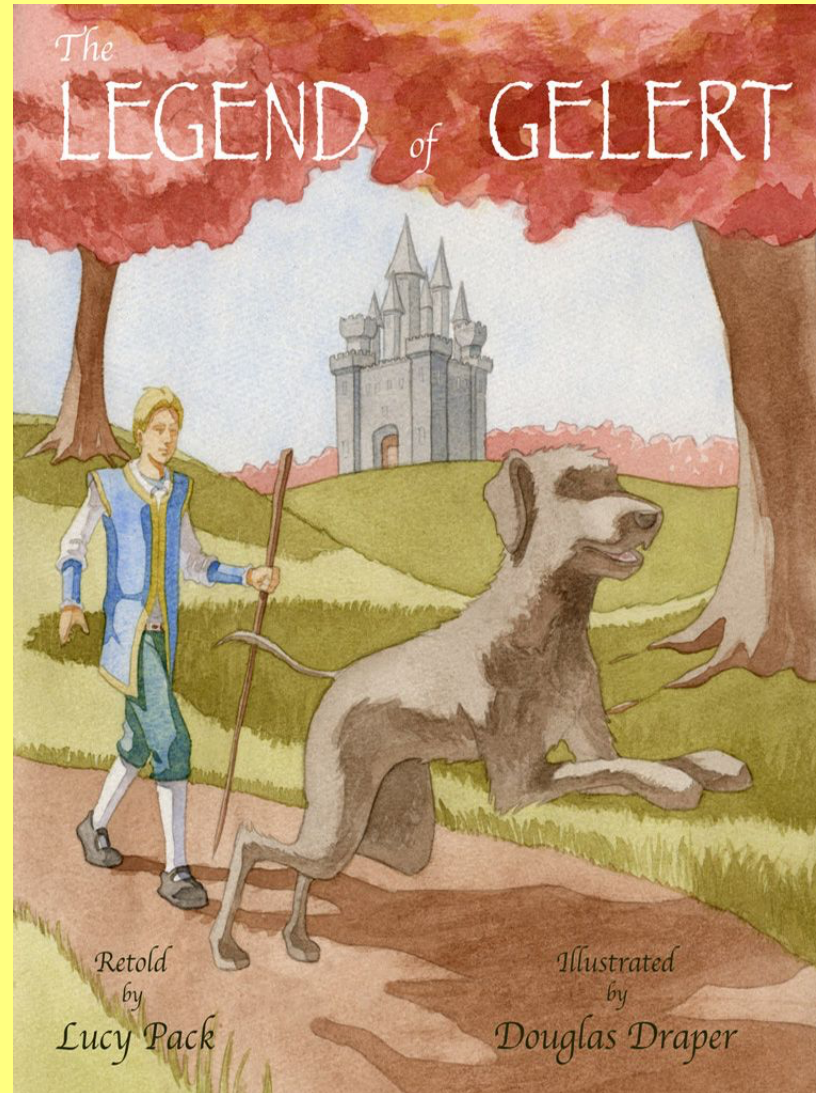


# English Wednesday

luxurious

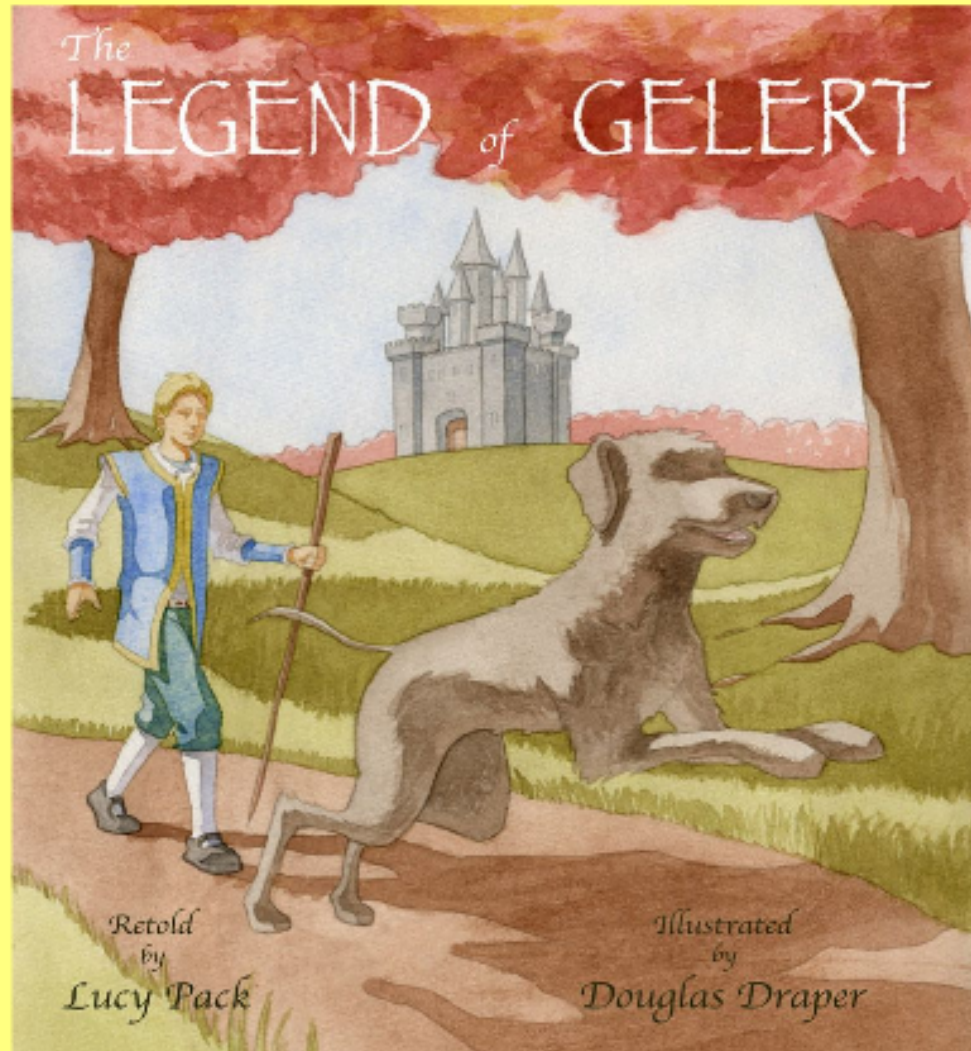
Yesterday, you used the information that you KNEW and what was IMPLIED to help you make a prediction about what may happen in this legend.
