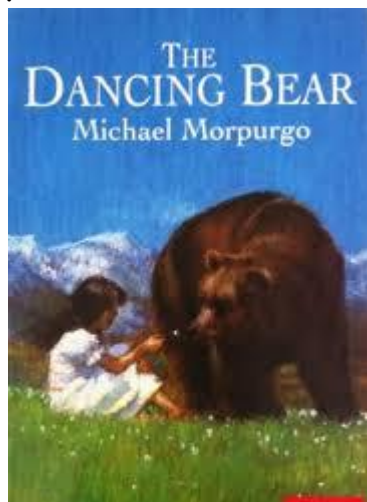

Please watch the video for the next part of the story and further instructions. Upload a photo of your work to SeeSaw.

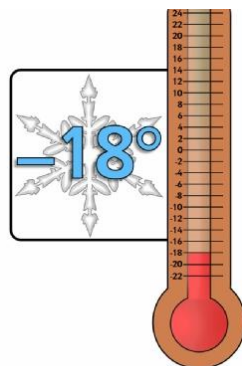


### CORE LEARNING TASK FOR MATHEMATICS
