CORE LEARNING TASK FOR ENGLISH

<u>Spelling Focus</u> – new words from the Y3 List: perhaps, often, natural, special, group. Handwriting activity on clear ascenders and descenders.

<u>English Writing Task</u> – Today, we would like you to use inverted commas to write direct speech in your writing. Watch the tutorial that shows examples from our class text.

CORE LEARNING TASK FOR MATHEMATICS This week our focus is fractions.

KEY VOCABULARY

Key vocabulary you will come across today includes **tremor**, **Richter Scale**, **plates**, **fault**, **hazard**, **impact**, **evacuation drill**. If you are unsure about the meaning of any of these words use <u>Thesaurus and Word Tools | WordHippo</u> to check their definition or try and work out the meaning from the context in which they are used.

WIDER CURRICULUM TASK

Geography – Where do earthquakes occur and how can we be safe during an earthquake?

Look through the powerpoint on 'Earthquakes.' Recap on last week's learning about the process. Discuss where earthquakes occur in the 'Ring of Fire.' Locate this on the map.

Watch **BBC Bitesize – A Visit to Mexico City part 2** about an earthquake drill in a school. Read about how to prepare for an earthquake and be safe.

TASK: Watch the video clip on espresso – earthquakes – Chilean Earthquake to observe the damage that an earthquake can do to a city. Discuss the hazards of living in an earthquake prone area with an adult. For example, loss of buildings, schools, homes, loss of power (like electricity), flooding, fires. How do the people feel? Why?
