




## Let's recap on the rules of ways of adding suffix –est to an adjective..


Rule#	Spelling Rule	Example
1	If the adjective ends in -e, add -st.	<ul> <li>nice → nicest</li> <li>safe → safest</li> <li>large → largest</li> </ul>
2	If the adjective ends in a consonant-vowel-consonant (CVC) pattern, double the final consonant and add -est.	<ul> <li>big → biggest</li> <li>wet → wettest</li> <li>flat → flattest</li> </ul>
3	If the adjective ends with a consonant + -y, change -y to -i and add -est.	<ul> <li>easy → easiest</li> <li>funny → funniest</li> <li>pretty → prettiest</li> </ul>
4	For all other adjectives, add -est.	tall → tallest     soft → softest     loud → loudest



Plural nouns name more than one person, place, or thing.













#### Plurals rule chart



Rules	Singular	Plural
Most nouns just add s.	cat	cats
Many nouns ending with a consonant + y change the y to i and add es.	baby	babies
Nouns ending with a vowel + y just add s.	toy	toys
Nouns ending with ch, sh, ss or × add es.	church	churches
Many nouns ending with for fe change this to a v and add es.	loaf	loaves
Nouns ending with a vowel + o add s.	radio	radios
Nouns ending with a consonant + o add es.	volcano	volcanoes
