What is an irregular plural noun?

An irregular noun is a noun that becomes plural by changing it's spelling in other ways than adding an "s" or "es" to the end of the word. Some of the ways can be a little tricky.

Examples of Irregular Plural Nouns

· Some irregular nouns take on the plural form by first changing the last letter of the word before adding "s." Words that end in "f" or are a good example of this case. To make such a word plural, you change the "f" to "ve" and add an "s."

Examples of Irregular Plural Nouns

 A tricky part about irregular plural words are sometimes they just change because there is a change in the vowel, change the word, or an add of different ending.









