CORE LEARNING TASK FOR ENGLISH

We really enjoyed reading the beginning of your stories yesterday and you used some great adjectives to describe the objects.

What happens in the middle of the story?

Task

Today you are going to write the middle of the story in your own words. Remember to use capital letters, full stops and finger spaces.

Challenge: Try to include a simile in your descriptions comparing an object to something else e.g. A rhinoceros as heavy as a boulder.

CORE LEARNING TASK FOR MATHEMATICS

Today we are thinking about grams and kilograms. Remember there are 1000 grams in a 1kg.

We use different units of measurement to find the mass of different objects. For lighter objects we use grams and for heavier objects we use kg. Have a look at the activity assigned for you on seesaw and see if you can work out which items will be weighed in grams and which in kg. You may also need to estimate how heavy you think the objects will be!

KEY VOCABULARY

Maths – heaviest, lightest, mass, weight, balance, gram, kilogram, order, sequence.

English – knock, orangutan, rhinoceros, bicycle, whale

Challenge - These words appear in the middle of our story and are very tricky to spell! Have a practise before you start writing and see if you can spell

WIDER CURRICULUM TASK

In PSHE today we are thinking about handwashing. Discuss the importance of handwashing. Please complete the sequencing activity assigned to you.

Then video yourself washing your hands remember to count to 20 or sing 'Happy Birthday' to make sure you wash your hands for long enough.
