We would also like you to complete a spelling activity, writing noun phrases including ent, ant, ence, ance, ancy, ency words – see the presentation.



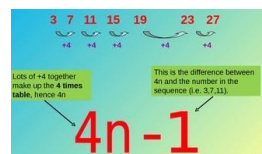
CORE LEARNING TASK FOR MATHEMATICS
