CORE LEANING TASK FOR ENGLISH

<u>Spelling Focus:</u> new spellings – watch the tutorial

<u>Grammar Focus:</u> spelling **contractions.** could've, would've, should've,

couldn't, wouldn't, shouldn't

CORE LEARNING TASK FOR MATHEMATICS

This week our focus is mass and capacity.

Today, we would like the children to start with ordering three-digit numbers. Select level 3, ordering, Three-Digit Numbers.

If you are unsure about the meaning of any of these words use <u>Thesaurus and Word Tools | WordHippo</u> to check their definition or try and work out the meaning from the context in which they are used.

WIDER CURRICULUM TASK

Art – LO: To create a 3D dragon's egg from papier mache. This task is for two afternoons.

Resources you will need: balloon, newspaper, paintbrush, half a cup of flour, half a cup of water, bowl to mix flour and water in to make your glue paste. Watered down PVA glue also works as a glue. Tomorrow, use paint and coloured paper to decorate in the style of Gaudi's mosaics. You may embellish with glitter, jewels, etc if you have them! Watch the tutorial by Mrs Brown. Let your egg dry overnight, then paint it the next day and decorate it like Gaudi!
