Finally today, we would like you to complete the space themed comprehension that is saved on the website. Take care to read the text and questions carefully, underlining the key parts of the question.



CORE LEARNING TASK FOR MATHEMATICS

Today is the final day this term that we will be spending time looking at Reflections and Translations. Remember a translation is where the shape slides within a quadrant and are identified by either a movement such as Left 3, down 2 or written as a vector $(-3, -2)$. Both of the translations are the same. A reflection is where the image is reflected in a given mirror line much the same as an image in the mirror but inverted (opposite to the original)
