### CORE LEARNING TASK FOR ENGLISH

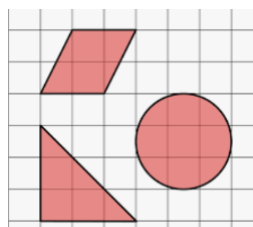
LO: To consider both sides of an argument, and to express opinions and justify them
