KEY VOCABULARY

Maths – half, array, multiply, groups of lots of.

Challenge - When we are comparing to nouns we use comparative adjectives. We add -er to the end of the adjective. If a word ends in 'y' we have to change the 'i' before adding the -er. Have a go at turning these adjectives into comparative adjectives.
