Colons can introduce a List

A colon shows when a list is about to begin.

My uncle Darren brought these things with him: an ice cream, a balloon, a gold necklace and sunglasses.

The colon introduces the list.

A colon can also introduce a list of bullet points.



This is what you need to wear in the snow:

- *A good pair of gloves,*
- *A warm hat,*
- *A pair of good boots,*
- *A carrot for a nose.*

The bit before the colon needs to be a main clause (see p.24-25).

If the first item has a capital letter, the rest should too. Lines must end with the same punctuation (a comma or semi-colon), apart from the last one which needs a full stop.

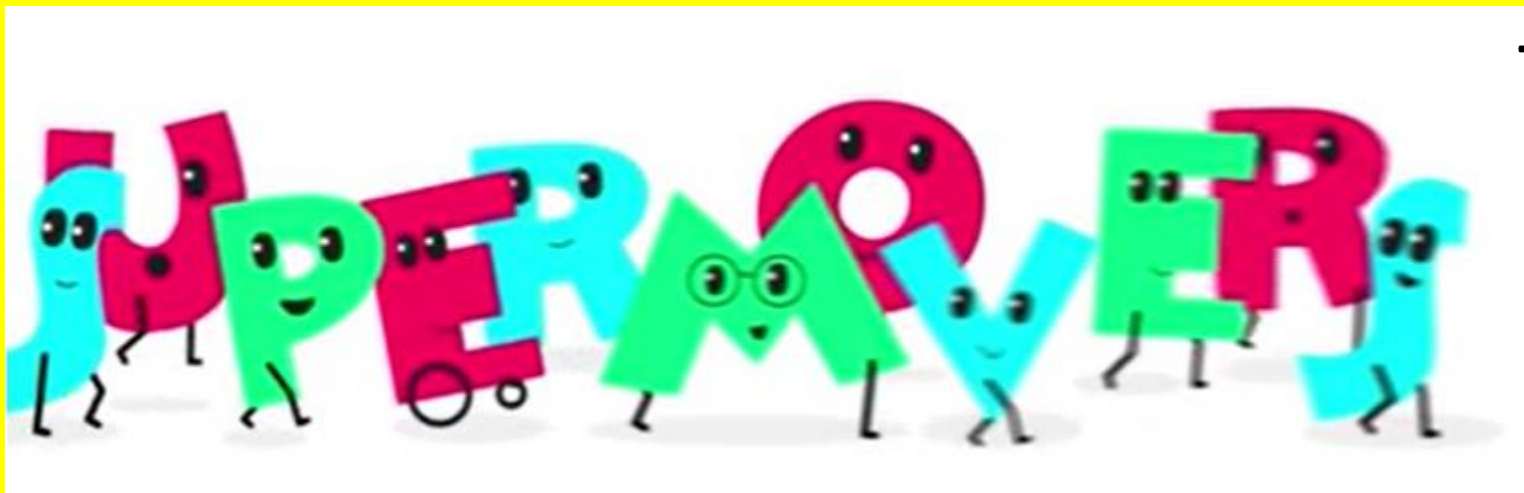
