CORE LEARNING TASK FOR MATHEMATICS

In maths today, we are going to continue to look at how to calculate the average. This is very MEAN, because you have to add up all the items of data and then divide it by how many items in the set!

We will also mention the median, which is another type of average – make sure that you know the differences between both.

1, 3, 3, **6**, 7, 8, 9 Median = $\frac{6}{5}$ 1, 2, 3, **4**, **5**, 6, 8, 9 Median = $(4+5) \div 2$ = $\frac{4.5}{5}$
