CORE LEANING TASK FOR ENGLISH

SPELLING FOCUS

This week, our spelling focus is all about adding the suffix - y to nouns to make adjectives, for example rain-rainy, wave-wavy.

ENGLISH

CORE LEARNING TASK FOR MATHEMATICS

This week, we are learning all about Subtraction. Think about what it means to subtract. Today we will be focussing on the subtraction of 2 digit-1 digit numbers.
