CORE LEARNING TASK FOR ENGLISH

SPELLING FOCUS

This week, our spelling focus is all about adding the suffix **-y** to nouns to make adjectives, for example rain- rainy, wave- wavy.

- Please write 4 sentences about the pictures on the video using an adjective ending with **y**.

ENGLISH

CORE LEARNING TASK FOR MATHEMATICS

This week, we have been learning all about Subtraction. Today we will be focussing on the subtraction of 2 digit numbers with exchanging.

STARTER

For your starter, we would like you to solve some multiplication questions. Please use arrays/ repeated addition to solve the questions.

MAIN TASKS

1. Recap what we need to do in order to subtract 2 digit- 2 digit? We need to look at the amount of ones/units we have.
2. Watch Miss Hough's video which shows you how to work out the answer to 2 digit- 2 digit with exchanging. It is really important to keep practising this method as it is quite different to adding!
3. No tasks have been specifically assigned on SeeSaw today. The questions that you will need to answer will be on the video today.

CHALLENGE

Solve the following problem based on the methods learnt today:

Ben has 63 beads.

He gives 37 beads away.

How many beads does Ben have left?

PHONICS

- Please play the following game which will recap on Phase 5 graphemes by reading words which include these. This game should be played daily.

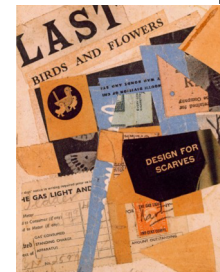
