# CORE LEARNING TASK FOR ENGLISH

Today we will write our Explanation text, which will EXPLAIN how the process of Day and Night works. Remember that the key features of an explanation text are;

- Written in chronological order
- Contains a process or cycle
- Tells the read HOW and WHEN something occurs
  - Is written in steps
- Contains adverbials and conjunctions to link the steps.

Your first task is to look back at your Science work from Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> Jan (2 weeks ago!) where you studied the Day and Night process. Then watch these videos as a reminder <u>BBC Bitesize</u>, <u>Video two</u>.

Finally, follow Mrs Sheppard's video, where she will start each 'step' for you. We have also put a key word mat on the website to help you with the correct vocabulary.



# CORE LEARNING TASK FOR MATHEMATICS

This morning we will be continuing the theme of calculating angle size using our prior knowledge. Please watch the video by Mr. Stanton looking at the ways we might solve the problem put in front of us.
