3. Decorate simple biscuits using icing sugar and lots of colourful sweets/sprinkles; just like the colours of Elmer! You could add some food colouring to your icing sugar.

5. Make your own Milk Jug Elmer – ask a grown-up to cut off the top of a milk carton. Stick lots of colourful paper squares all over Elmer! Don't forget to add Elmer's eyes and ears!
6. Pin the trunk on Elmer! – on espresso, search for '**Pin the trunk on Elmer**'. Print the poster off and stick it onto a wall/door using some blu tack. Cut out Elmer's trunk and stick some blu tack on the back. Wearing a blindfold, try and stick Elmer's trunk in the right position.
