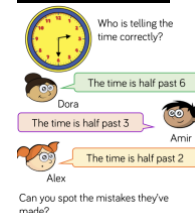
#### STARTER

We will be reminding ourselves how to read a numberline and find the missing numbers on the numberline. The sheet will be available on the remote learning page.

#### MAIN TASKS

1. Remember what the clock hands represent. The minute hand is the bigger and the hour hand is smaller. The hour tells us what hour is it. The minute tells us how many minutes.
2. A clock is just like a numberline with the hands telling us the minute and hour.
3. If you have a clock make the time that Miss Rimmer is saying to help answer your questions or use the online clock (linked above).
4. Problem solving questions have been assigned to you on SeeSaw.
