CORE LEARNING TASK FOR ENGLISH

This morning marks the start of an exciting new English topic! We will be studying a text called Journey to the River Sea – which is set in the Amazon Rainforest (which we will be studying in Geography).

Watch Mrs Sheppard's video where she will talk you through the lesson. You will need [this link](#) at the start of the lesson. Once you have watched the clip, think about the questions that Mrs Sheppard asks and jot down your thoughts. Then look at the English Rainforest Phrases sheet (on the website). Which of these phrases seem the most relevant and impactful when describing the rainforest? You can either use a pencil to draw your own 'zones of relevance' chart and write the phrases neatly in the correct section OR print ours out and cut out the phrases (then send us photograph of your work).

There are also two 'refresher sheets' for you to complete, to remind yourself of some of the key skills that we have looked at before. Finally, listen to the first chapter of the book.



CORE LEARNING TASK FOR MATHEMATICS

Today we are revisiting a topic we covered not so long ago, but then later in the week it will move forward when we will look at Division using the written method of chunking.

But today we are going to start with a quick couple of rounds of mental multiplication and division using Daily 10 here, <https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/daily10>

We are then going to work on factors of numbers. Can you remember what the definition of a factor is? What are they?

Follow the video with Mr. Stanton, answering the questions along the way before having a go yourselves. Don't forget to try the Plenary question at the end to further your understanding and investigate abundant numbers.
