<u>Place Value</u>

Today we will look at ordering and comparing numbers. To begin with do you know what the words ascending and descending mean? If not look them up in a dictionary.

How could you arrange the following numbers in ascending or descending order? 2, 1480, 679, 34 1357, 1359, 1456, 1462 6549, 7432, 7439, 6635
