CORE LEARNING TASK FOR MATHEMATICS

Today we are beginning to add to digits today. We are going to be using Base 10 jottings to help us. Please watch the video to see how we draw jottings for different numbers.

When you have drawn jottings you need to add the numbers together. Remember to add the tens together and then the ones.

Top tip – when you are drawing the jottings draw one in each box. It will really help you when you are counting them up.
