CORE LEARNING TASK FOR ENGLISH


Today, we will be revisiting Maia's journey down the Amazon and learning a section using our Talk for Writing techniques. This will then help us to write our own version for our setting description, later in the week.

CORE LEARNING TASK FOR MATHEMATICS



Continuing our theme for the week we are going to look at using our knowledge of multiplication and division, especially related division facts to solve more problems mentally. Firstly though, we are going to start with converting between mixed numbers and improper fractions. Today we are reversing the process and going from mixed numbers to improper fractions. Watch the video for hints. Next we are going to look at how to solve number calculations using know facts such as knowing that $6 \times 6 = 36$ then we could derive the solutions for questions such as 6000 ÷ 60 and 36000 ÷600. Continue to watch the video before attempting as many questions as the hour allows.
