Suggestion Boxes	<p>Children brought suggestions from the class suggestion boxes.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Improvements to recycling in school. The children, during discussion made suggestions about introducing a plastic free day (linked to pack lunches) and looking for alternatives for bringing food into school. The children also discussed and made suggestions for using different recycling bins for different recycling. The recycling bins at the moment take mixed recycling so MS suggested being more pro active at rinsing more plastic waste and recycling rather than throwing away. • Keeping as many trees as possible. Elaboration needed although MS reassured the council that the trees that have been taken down were because of disease or Health and Safety concerns. Trees can and will be acquired where we can to replace and increase the numbers on the school grounds. MS has a number at home getting ready for planting. Suggestion made about planting in particular shapes. • Class Plant Suggestion made for every class to have a class plant which the children are responsible for with links to improving mental health. • Litter pick When put to a vote all children voted in favour to take part in a litter pick around school. Children then suggested about producing posters about litter as some of the bins become an area where litter isn't placed correctly in the bins and spill out onto the floor. Children also suggested putting pictures of animals on the bins to improve identification and understanding of how putting litter in bins could be beneficial to these. Also made a link about green waste and could we, as a school, compost green waste. ACTION – Create posters about litter and littering. • Meat Free Mondays – Children suggested a completely meat free day. MS to speak to JL about the possibility but spoke to the children about freedom of choice.
