From Farm to Fork!

This week we have been exploring the journey that food makes from the farm to our fork! We have learnt lots of interesting facts like there are 7000 different varieties of apple and it takes 20 days for bananas to sail from Costa Rica to the UK! There are lots of short videos produced by Tesco 'Farm to Fork' on YouTube that are great to watch. In our maths lessons we have been learning about measuring length, height, width and weight. We have been using uniform non-standard measures e.g. cubes to measure the length, height, width and weight of different vegetables!
