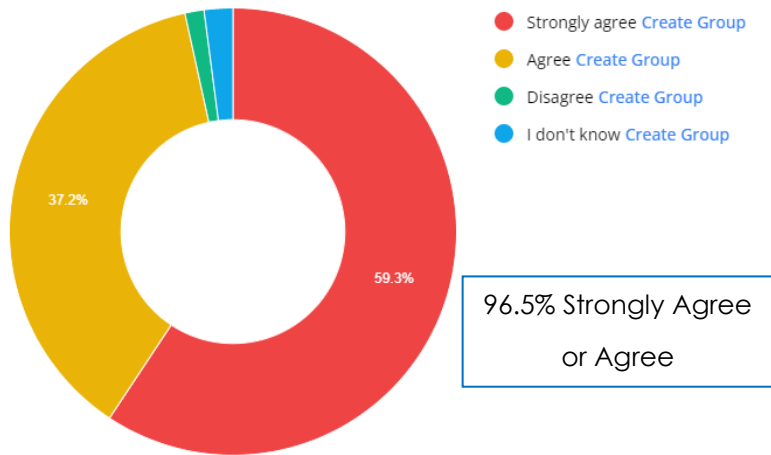
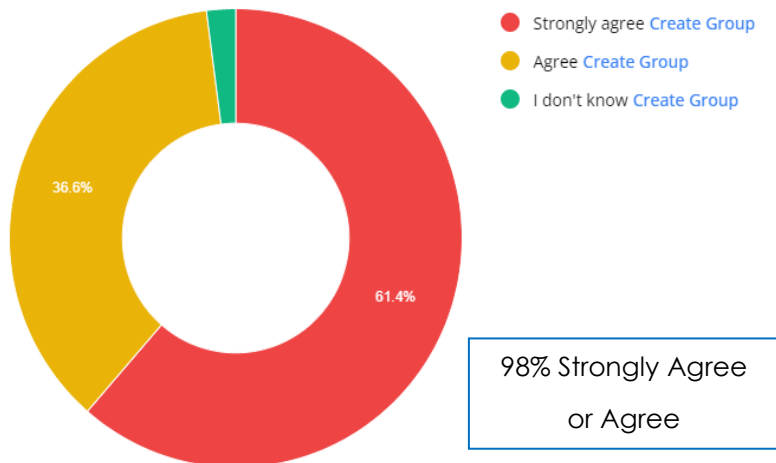




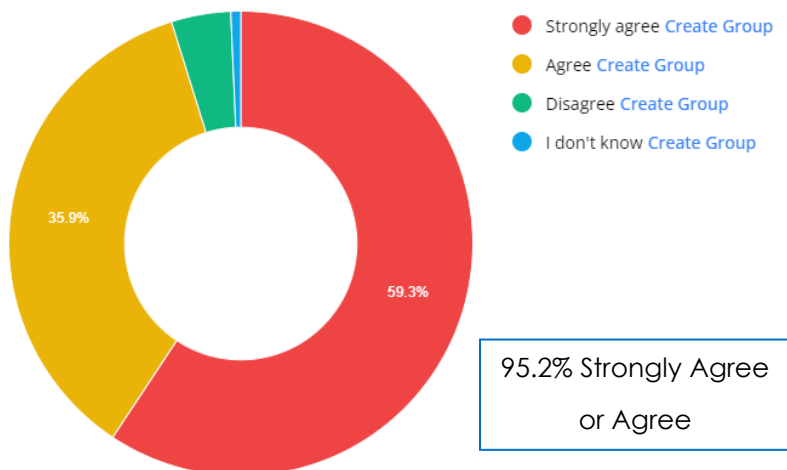
Sherwood Primary School has high expectations for my child
