

EYFS Personal, Social and Emotional Development



From the outset in EYFS, we carefully plan provision to support children's Personal, Social and Emotional Development. For children to be successful in all areas of learning, they need to feel secure and to develop a positive sense of themselves. Much of our provision is based on the need to provide opportunities for personal, social and emotional development.

We aim to enable children to:

- Respect themselves and others and develop a positive self-image.
- Take turns and share.
- Feel confident to take risks and cope with mistakes.
- Form positive attachments to adults, make friends and co-operate in a group.
- Develop a positive attitude to learning.
- Understand and embrace differences in gender, special needs, ethnicity, religion and cultures.

We teach our children how to assess risks in different situations and deliver explicit teaching on Road Safety and online Safety.
