READING BOOKS

Please remember that reading books are changed on a **Tuesday** and a **Thursday** each week. We encourage the children to discuss their reading more and keep revisiting their book. Please can the children ensure they bring in their reading diary and reading books into school every day. Children will also be visiting the Library on a Tuesday afternoon so please ensure library books are brought into school every day.

PE

We will be completing our PE sessions on a **Friday** this half term. Please can we stress that children need to have a **LABELLED** indoor and outdoor PE kit. We will not be able to locate missing items if they are unnamed.

KEY KNOWLEDGE

By the end of this half term, we would like the children to be able to locate Beacon Fell on a map. We would also like the children to recognise human and physical features on and around Beacon Fell. We will be revisiting what each symbol on a map means and what a key is used for. We would also like the children to compare Sherwood and Beacon Fell and identify different wildlife living in both areas.

THIS HALF TERM WE ARE READING:

This half term we will be reading 'Cinderboy', which is an enjoyable twist on the modern fairytale Cinderella. Ask your child to predict what could happen in Cinderboy.

CLASS TEXTS: We are also reading class texts usually at the end of the school day. 2KH are still reading 'The Twits' by Roald Dahl and 2AH are reading 'I Swapped My Brother on the Internet' by Jo Simmons.

WRITING FOCUS

This half term we are still reminding the children to use capital letters and the correct punctuation at the end of sentences. We are also encouraging the children to say their sentence first, write it and then read it back to check it makes sense. We are going to be focusing on using the conjunctions **and**, **but** and **or**. We will also be looking at writing in the past tense and how some verbs don't always follow the adding -ed rule. We will also be looking at commas and using these in lists.

KEY MATHS SKILLS

In Maths this half term, we will be focussing on the following skills:

- Recognising different coins and finding totals of amounts.
- Learning all about arrays in Multiplication and using these in problems.
- Learning about grouping and sharing and using these methods to solve division calculations.
- Learning about telling the time. Can you test your child on their knowledge of time?
- Discuss with them what times they are aware of during their daily routine (what time they go to school, go to bed, eat tea etc.)
