READING BOOKS

KEY KNOWLEDGE

We would like children to know the history of their local area of Sherwood. The children will make predictions about what they think was here before. They will use historical maps to find out if they were correct. They will look at photographs of the school as it has grown. Which parts of the school are older than others? The children will be able to give a clear explanation of how Sherwood has changed over time and how it continues to change.

THIS HALF TERM WE ARE READING:

This half term we will be reading 'Chilly Billy'- The Man who lives in the fridge! The children will be reading about Chilly Billy's important job he has! The children will write their own Chilly Billy adventure based on these short stories.

CLASS TEXTS: We are still reading class texts usually at the end of the school day. 2KH are still reading 'The Twits' by Roald Dahl and 2AH will be reading 'I Swapped my Brother on the Internet' by Jo Simmons.

WRITING FOCUS

This half term we will be continuing to focus on writing in full sentences which begin with a capital letter and end with a full stop. This half term we are focusing on using apostrophes for posession. We will also be trying to include the words 'while', 'as', 'before' and 'after' to relate to time. We will use the past tense to write our own Chilly Billy stories. We will also be learning about and planning our own stories using a story map.

KEY MATHS SKILLS

In Maths this half term, we will be recapping our knowledge of Place Value. We will be reminding ourselves what partition means and how many ways we can partition 2 digit numbers. We will be looking at shape, particularly focusing on 3D shapes and the properties of these (how many faces, sides and edges each shape has). We will be then carrying out some practical work based on the mass of objects. We will compare and order different masses. We will also be revising our division knowledge and the two different ways we can solve division problems. We will also recap on using different amounts of money to work out change.
